Past Simple (regular verbs)

● **-ed Writing:**

- *the normal rule is to add -ed*
- *if the verb ends in -e, add -d.*
- *if the verb has only 1 syllable and 1 vowel + 1 consonant, double the consonant.*
- **consonant** + y = **ied**
- **vowel** + y = **ed**

wash – **washed** cook – **cooked**

receive – **received** bake – **baked**

drop – **dropped**

study – **studied** carry – **carried**

stay – **stayed** play – **played**
